


Announced in May 2020 in the EU **Biodiversity Strategy for 2030**

Launched in October 2020 as one of the first implemented actions of the EU Biodiversity Strategy for 2030 to

- 1. track and assess progress by the EU and its partners
- 2. foster cooperation and partnership
- underpin policy development with ad hoc scientific, technical and practitioners' advice



The Knowledge Centre for Biodiversity (KCBD)



The KCBD is managed by the **Joint Research Centre** (JRC), the European Commission's in-house science service.

The KCBD is a one-stop shop service in support to biodiversity for the EC

COP15, of the Biological Diversity (CBD) established a mechanism consisting of a network of regional and/or subregional technical and scientific cooperation support centres, to be coordinated at the global level by a global coordination entity.

Focus: capacity building for helping Parties implement the GBF

At the fourth meeting of the Subsidiary Body on Implementation (SBI 4) of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD), the Parties selected 18 regional organizations spanning the globe in a multilateral push to bolster the implementation of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework, also known as the Biodiversity Plan, through science, technology and innovation:

- Africa: The Central African Forest Commission (COMIFAC), the Ecological Monitoring Center (CSE), the Regional Centre for Mapping of Resources for Development (RCMRD), the Sahara and Sahel Observatory (OSS), and the South African National Biodiversity Institute (SANBI).
- Americas: The Alexander von Humboldt Biological Resources Research Institute, the Secretariat of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), and the Central American Commission on Environment and Development (CCAD).
- Asia: ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity (ACB); IUCN Asia Regional Office; IUCN Regional Office for West Asia (ROWA); Nanjing Institute of Environmental Sciences (NIES); Regional Environmental Centre for Central Asia (CAREC).
- Europe: European Commission Joint Research Centre of the European Commission (JRC); IUCN
 Centre for Mediterranean Cooperation; IUCN Regional Office for Eastern Europe and Central Asia
 (ECARO); Royal Belgian Institute for Natural Sciences (RBINS).
- Oceania: The Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme (SPREP).





Core functions of the regional and/or subregional centres of the technical and scientific cooperation mechanism

In accordance with decision 15/8, paragraph 26, the core functions of the regional and/or subregional centres of the technical and scientific cooperation mechanism are the following:

(a) To promote and facilitate, on a demand-driven basis, technical and scientific cooperation and technology transfer among Parties, especially from developed country Parties to developing country Parties, to support the implementation of the Convention and of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework, including through joint research programmes and joint ventures for the development of technologies relevant to the objectives of the Convention;

Unique opportunity to

- enhance and strengthen existing networks;
- streamline and align reporting processes;
- fill gaps where needed;
- take national and subregional specificities into account.

It is up to us to make it useful!

- Promote scientific cooperation




